I know. That's the part that bothers me.

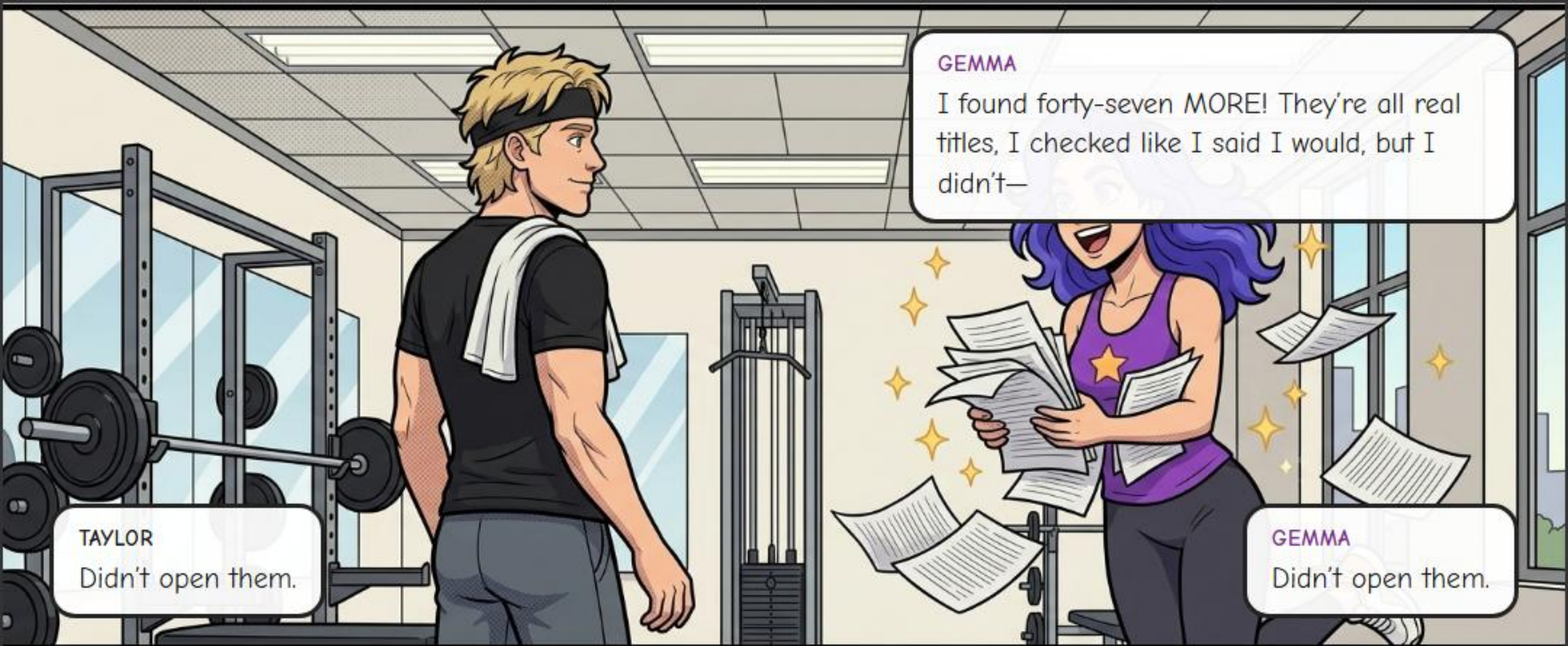

Did you open any of them?

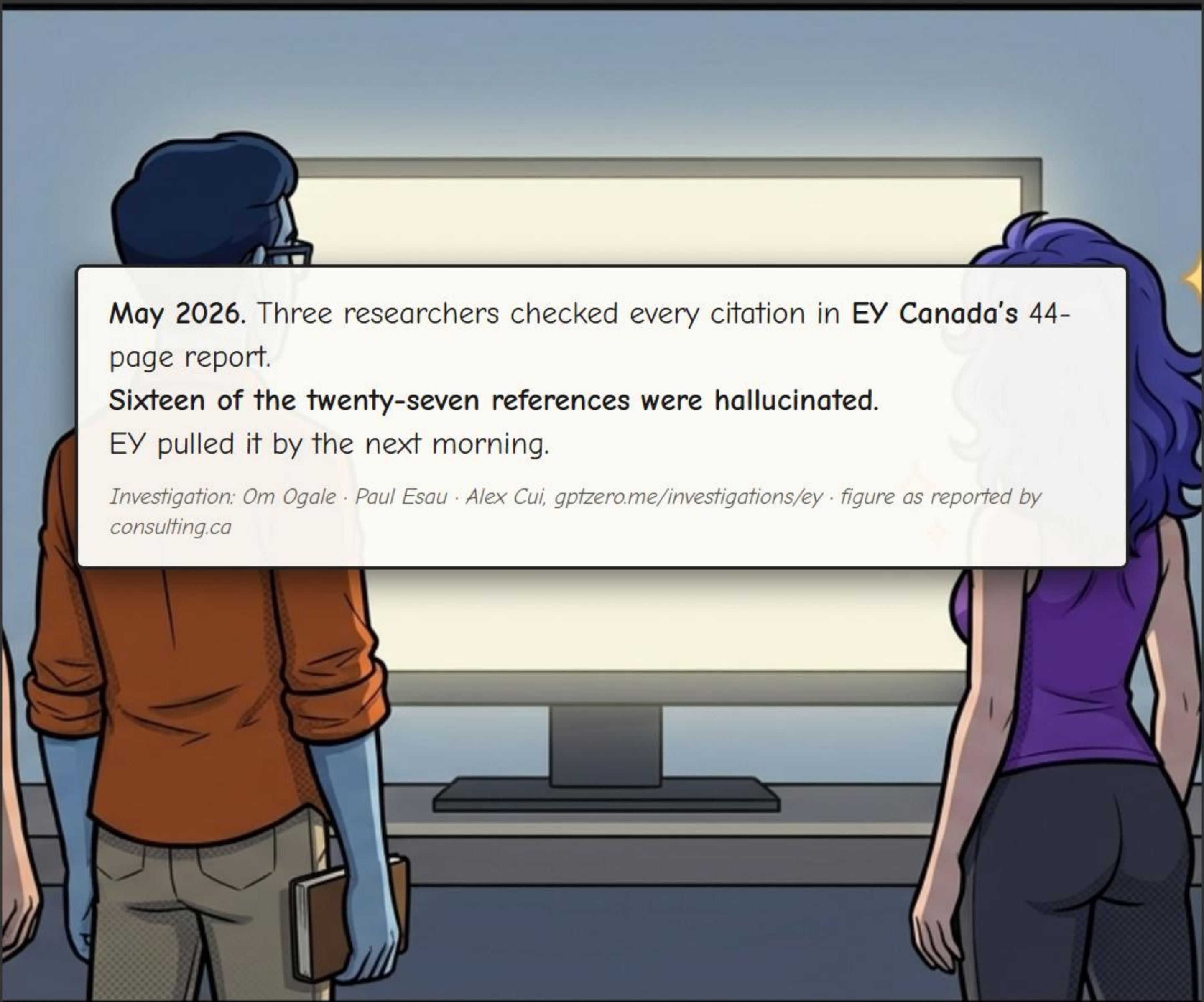


CLAUDIO

It settles on sixteen. I didn't get that from the counter, I got it from the write-up. I almost printed the zero.



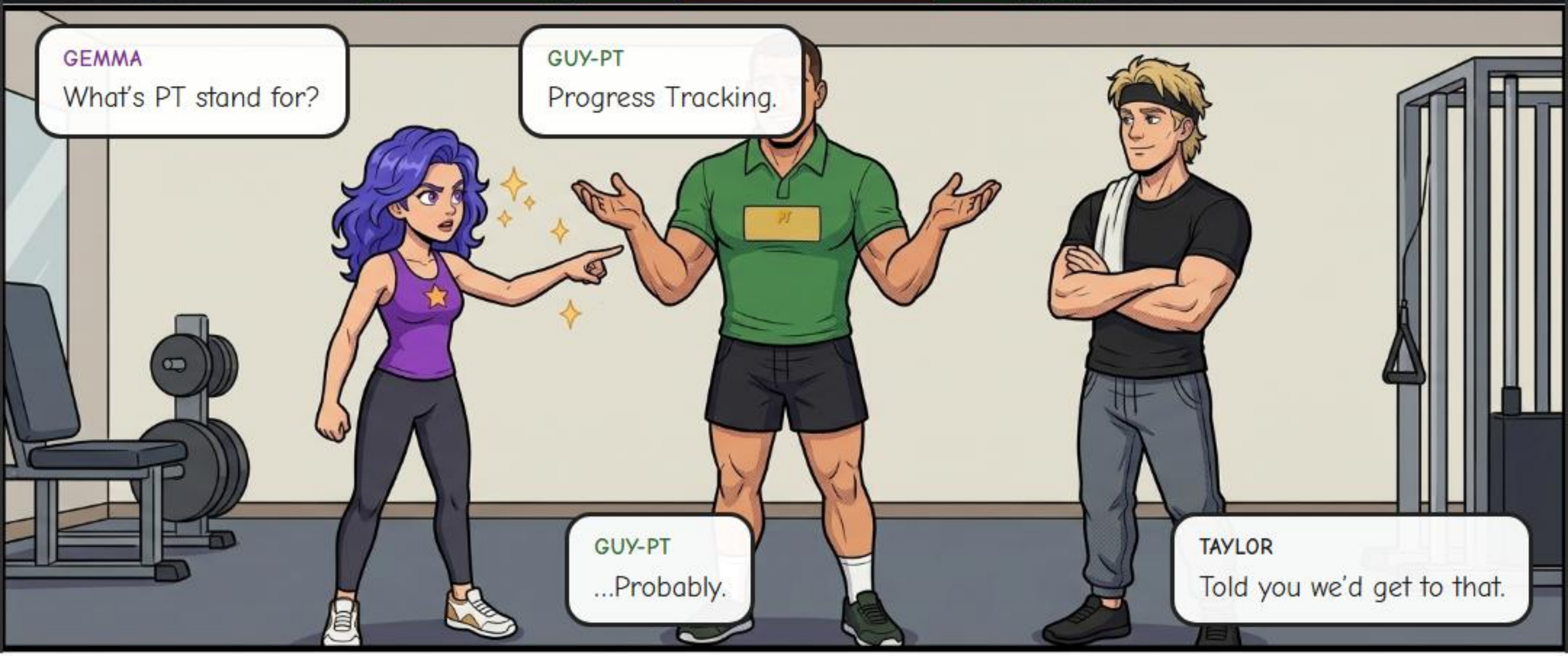
GUY-PT

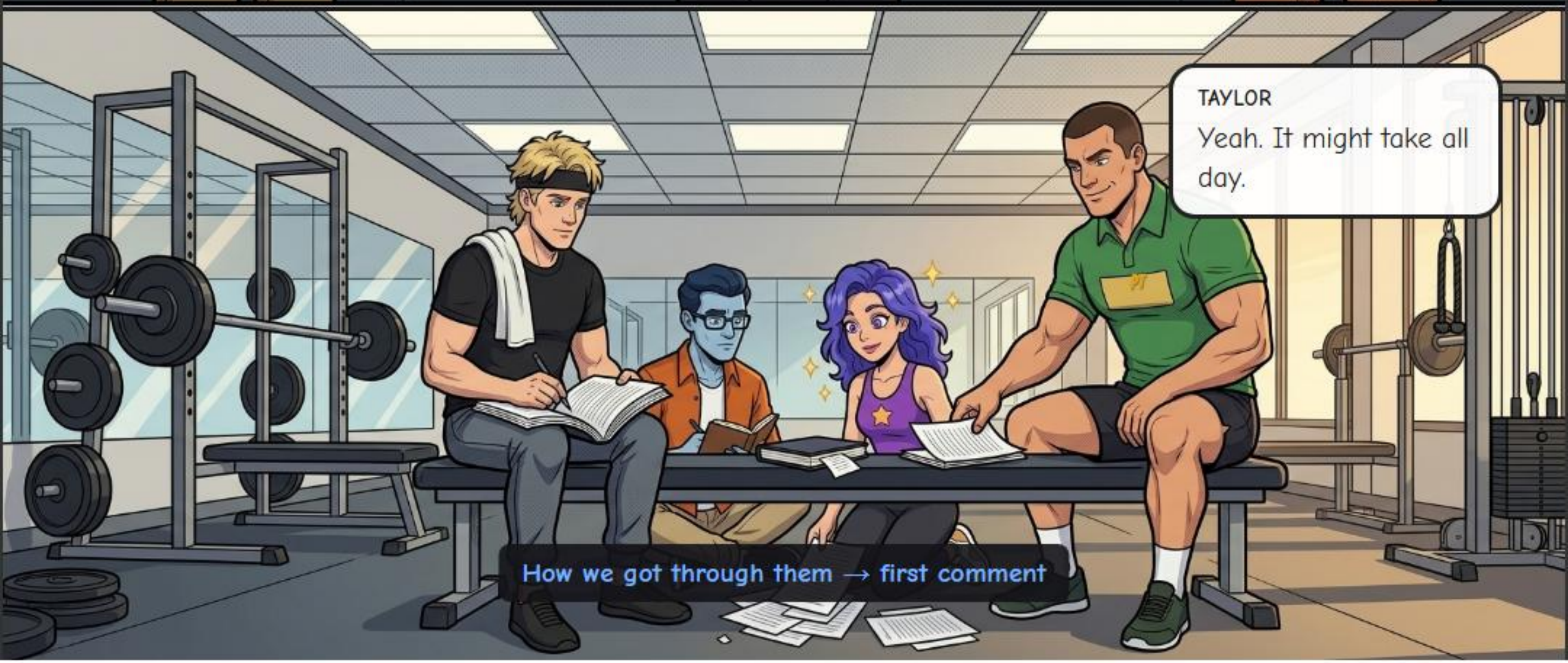
